# CHECK-UP CHECKLIST



## Prepare for your visit



### Have answers ready

Have some basic info, like your cat's age, and any previous vaccinations, health issues or surgeries



### Use a cat carrier

Try and acclimate your cat early on by placing treats and toys inside the carrier



### Enjoy the ride

Avoid feeding your cat at least one hour before leaving to avoid car sickness



### Treat often

In the waiting room, praise and treat your cat to help them feel comfortable

## During the check-up



### Body condition

Does your cat go outside often? Expect a check for weight, parasites, etc.



### Joints & mobility

Reflexes will be tested. Your vet will ask about their activity level.



### Respiratory

Does your cat wheeze or struggle to breathe?



### Oral & digestive

Any changes in appetite? Stool? Check for healthy teeth, gums and breath.



### Urinary

Any accidents outside the litter box?



### Glands

Expect a check of the lymph nodes, anal glands, etc.

## Post-checkup questions



Does anything seem unusual about my cat's health?



Any recommended changes to their food/diet?



Any necessary vaccinations or follow-up visits?
